The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.109 dated 07.10.2019 under Sections 307 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner was travelling in the car, being driven by her son, which was signalled to stop by the police personnel and instead of stopping, they sped away. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about two months and the son of the petitioner is also in custody.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Ajwinder Singh, contends that the petitioner is involved in liquor smuggling and has been convicted in as many as 26 cases under the Excise Act. He also contends that investigation is on the verge of completion and the challan shall be filed shortly.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about two months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
