The petitioner filed the writ petition raising a grievance with regard to grant of permit under Stage Carriage Scheme, 2016. The writ petition was disposed of on 4.9.2019 with a direction to the respondent-Secretary Regional Transport Authority, Rohtak (for short, 'the Authority') to decide the representation dated 20.7.2019 in a time-bound manner. It was further ordered that the Authority will pay due regard to the documents placed along with the writ petition and take decision within reasonable time.

The grievance raised in the present contempt petition is that the needful has not been done by the respondent.

It is pertinent to note here that there was no time-bound direction and needful was to be done within reasonable period.

No case is made out for initiating contempt proceedings against

the respondent.

The contempt petition is dismissed.

However, it is expected that the representation of the petitioner would be decided by the Authority within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today.
