ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.288 dated 30.08.2018 under Sections 380/427/440 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhiwani Civil Line, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arrayed only on the basis of suspicion. The allegations are that sensor of the complainant's car had been stolen. She also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

The Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 24.12.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satya Narayan, states that the petitioner has joined investigation but he has not helped in the recovery of the sensor.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 24.12.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
