Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.395 dated 14.11.2018, under Sections 323,325 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Rajendra Park, District Gurugram.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 20.12.2018:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the dispute is between the cousin brothers. As per the MLR, there is only bleeding from the nose and an abrasion thereon, which is not grievous in nature.

Notice of motion for 15.03.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section

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438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Sachin has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 20.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
