Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had paid money to the private respondents for getting him a Study Visa for Canada but neither the money was repaid nor Visa was provided. A detailed representation dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) has been submitted to respondent No. 3 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. P.S. Walia, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to serve the private respondents or to seek reply from the official respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
