Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.860 dated 10.10.2018, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, under Sections 18 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, only 355 grams of opium was recovered in the present case which falls in non-commercial quantity.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 10.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
