Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.271 dated 18.11.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, submits that after registration of the FIR, offences under Section 376 IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act have been added in the case.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file a fresh petition after incorporating the sections added after registration of the case.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforesaid.

However, in order to file a fresh petition for anticipatory bail, the order dated December 20, 2018 which is continued till today, shall remain in force for another one week.
