The present petition was filed with the following prayer:-

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer for directing respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case of FIR No.50 dated 21.03.2018, registered under Sections 323/325/506/34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar and to submit a final report in this regard.

Further prayer for directing respondents No.2 to 5 to protect life and liberty and her family from the hands of private respondents

OR

direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper may kindly be passed in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajaypal Singh, has submitted that investigation in FIR No.50 dated 21.03.2018 has been completed. The challan has been presented in Court and the charges have also been framed, therefore, if the petitioner has any grievance, has to

file the application before the Court where trial is pending.

As regards second prayer, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar has filed an affidavit that necessary directions have been issued to DCP (Investigation), Jalandhar who has further issued directions to ACP (West), Jalandhar as well as SHO, Police Station Bhargo Camp.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner was beaten up and the aforesaid fact has been recorded in a compact disc which is also proved from the MLR.

In the considered view of this Court, it would be appropriate for the petitioner to raise such grievance before the Court where the case is pending.

With these observations, the petition is disposed of.
