The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.822 dated 01.10.2017 registered under Section 379 IPC (420, 201, 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on) at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. The name of the petitioner was not even mentioned in the FIR. He was sought to be involved in the case only by alleging that he was involved in fabrication of the chesis number upon some stolen vehicle. However, regarding any such activity, no material has been collected by the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019 and there is no other case against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhupender Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in a heinous crime. Still further, it is submitted that QR Code of a registration number of a vehicle has been duly recovered from the petitioner. However, it is not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019 and that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
