This criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas corpus for appointment of Warrant Officer to trace out the detenue mentioned in para No.2 of the instant petition and release them from the illegal custody and detention of respondent Nos.4 and 5 forthwith.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds it strange that the petitioner, who was working with his wife and children at the alleged brick kiln for the last 1 year and 6 months, ran away from there leaving behind them, to file the petition.

The contents of the petition lack all kinds of particulars and do not inspire confidence, therefore, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

The petition is dismissed.
