The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Ramandeep Kaur, in case FIR No.33 dated 17.07.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3 / 4 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur.

It has been submitted that the prosecutrix was subjected to rape by one Genta. However, petitioner has been arraigned solely on the ground that she has hatched a criminal conspiracy with said Genta. She was arrested on 06.10.2018 and since then she is in custody. She is having a kid.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, therefore, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the

satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate,
concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
