On 18.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.0286, dated 24.10.2019, registered under
Sections 452/427/323/341/147/149 IPC, at Police Station
Sadar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that the petitioner is alleged to have beaten the injured by
giving him fist and kick blows. He further submits that
the petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated.

Notice of motion for 09.12.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. SPS Tinna,
Addl.A.G.,Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.
A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. SPS Tinna,
Addl.A.G.,Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the

petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 18.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
