Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 84 dated 13.07.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was arrested on 13.07.2019 and since then he has been in custody alongwith another co-accused. He further states that by now, the petitioner has undergone 4 months 6 days. The recovery is of 137 gms intoxicant tablets containing salt of Tramadol Hydrochloride. He further states that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

On the instructions from ASI Niresh Pal, learned State counsel

states that the challan has been presented and charges are yet to be framed and no other case is pending against the petitioner. The custody certificate by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh Sidhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala, filed by the learned State counsel in Court today, is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 4 months 6 days.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
