ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 76, dated 30.08.2019, under Sections 379-B, 413, 411 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station City Kurali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner along with co-accused had snatched the mobile phone of the complainant. The petitioner is 28 years old and is in custody for over 3 ½ months. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Avtar Singh states that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 3 ½ months, he is not

involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
