ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1097 dated 01.10.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 427, 506, 455 & 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner along with co-accused had caused heavy damage to the hotel of the complainant. He further contends that no one was injured in the occurrence. The petitioner is 20 years of age and he is in custody for about 2½ months. He also contends that co-accused Sanjeev Kumar and Ajay have been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-49007-2019 and CRM-M-49800-2019 decided on 26.11.2019 and 02.12.2019 respectively.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but the charges are yet to be framed. He also submits that heavy damage was caused to the hotel of the complainant.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is 20 years of age, he is in custody for about 2½ months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
