Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of writ of Mandamus by directing the respondents to correct the name of the petitioner from 'Komal Devi' to 'Komal' in the official record of the CBSE in accordance with the CBSE Guidelines and Rules/Manual for Rules and Regulations 69.1.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has filed representation Annexure P-9 dated 2.8.2019 praying for the aforementioned relief but the same has not been decided by the CBSE Authorities till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent-CBSE to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-9 dated 02.08.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent-CBSE to consider and

decide the representation Annexure P-9 dated 02.08.2019 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
