Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to register a cross-version case against respondents No.5 to 8.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last two dates. Similar is the position today.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar is on record and as per this reply, the Investigating Officer, after obtaining opinion of the Medical Officer, has found that the injuries are simple in nature and therefore, the petitioner can file a complaint under Section 323 IPC before the trial Court. It is further stated in the reply that challan in the main FIR No.170 dated 12.10.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506, 148, 149 IPC already stands presented before the Illaqa Magistrate and the police has taken preventive steps and has also registered a DDR No.19 dated 16.11.2018 under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous.
However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a complaint before the
Illaqa Magistrate, if so advised.
