Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.140, dated 18.08.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 420,467,468,471,506,120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case against the petitioner is totally false and concocted. Since the case against the petitioner itself was false, therefore, even the complainant has not supported the same, while appearing as a witness before the Trial Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 31.08.2018. He is not required in any other case.

On the other hand, learned State counsel being instructed by ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in heinous crime of fraud. However, it is not disputed that the complainant himself has not supported the case of the prosecution and that the petitioner is not in custody in any other case except the present one, as of today.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
