The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to take necessary action against private respondents No.4 to 8 on the basis of FIR No.172 dated 22.09.2019 under Sections 376, 506 and 323 IPC registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the photographs (Annexure P-1) regarding the injuries suffered on the persons of the petitioner-victim. He states that despite the FIR having been registered on 22.09.2019, no action has been taken by the police. The petitioner had also submitted a representation dated 21.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members and further to take legal action against the accused persons, but no action has been taken on the said

representation. At this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Jasleen Kaur Sidhu, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to strictly act in accordance with law.
