AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J (ORAL)

This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction directing the respondents to remove the illegal structure raised during the pendency of the writ petition.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the official respondents at the first instance raising all the pleas as sought to be raised in the present writ petition. However, it was prayed that a time bound direction be given to them to decide the same.

3. After perusing the present petition and without going into the merits of the controversy, we permit the withdrawal of present writ petition. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach the concerned department by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as have been sought to be raised in the present writ petition before the concerned department.

4. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioners within a period of 2 weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order, the same shall be decided by the concerned department by passing a speaking order expeditiously, in accordance with law.
