Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 78 dated 19.06.2019 registered under Sections 22 and 25 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition on behalf of petitioner No. 2-Veerpal Kaur.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No. 1-Jagwinder Singh is husband of petitioner No. 2-Veerpal Kaur, is in custody since 19.06.2019 and nobody in their family is there to look-after their children. The alleged 680 tablets of Clivido-100-SR were recovered from the possession of petitioner No. 2-Veerpal Kaur and no other case is pending or decided qua petitioner No. 1.

On the instructions from SI Jaspal Singh, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that the challan has been presented and out of 12 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner No. 1- Jagwinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
