KULDIP SINGH J. (Oral)

Allegations against the petitioner are of snatching of Rs.6000/- and one mobile phone. Petitioner is in custody since 21.6.2018. As per learned State counsel, there is no other case against the petitioner.

As the disposal of trial/case will take time, therefore, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave the country without the prior intimation to this Court.

(ii)Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and

(iii)Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
