Petitioner-Dharam Pal has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.168 dated 05.10.2019 registered under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

The FIR was registered on the statement of the complainant, namely, Rachna wherein it was alleged that on 05.10.2019 at about 6.05 a.m., when complainant and her husband had gone for a walk, then three unidentified youths came on motorcycle and snatched one gold ring and a pair of ear rings from them. They gave knife blow on the complainant. Thereafter, 3-4 other persons came and followed the assailants but they all escaped after causing injuries to the complainant's husband and above said persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is not even

named in the FIR. He further submits that the alleged motor cycle bearing No.PB-32-Z-9154 was owned by him, however, the same was stolen a day before the alleged occurrence.

It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that no complaint was made by the petitioner regarding the theft of his vehicle.

Considering the allegations that the victim attempted to thwart the snatching by the accused persons and suffered injuries at the hands of the assailants, this Court does not find any ground for grant of extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
