The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 09.08.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 341, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

The role attributed to the petitioner is that he simply caused hurt to one Somvati and further allegation against him is that he along with other accused caught hold the hands of the victim and then the main accused-Malkit Singh gave a sword blow to the victim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court on 22.05.2019 vide CRM-M-22362-2019 and CRM-M-22383-2019.

The petitioner is in custody since 11.08.2017. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the principle of parity as well as the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
