This is second bail application filed by the petitioner in criminal case arising from FIR No.298 dated 17.09.2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 506, 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh. First bail application filed by the petitioner was withdrawn by the learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime.
