AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking directions to the respondent-bank to release the land of the petitioner alongwith sale deed and other documents from the loan account. The petition was disposed of on 28.08.2019. The Court without adverting into the merits of the case, directed the respondent-bank to consider legal notice dated 17.08.2018. It was further ordered that in case after further consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible, the consequential relief be allowed, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, if the relief claimed was not found admissible, a

speaking order was to be passed.

The contempt petition is filed pleading that needful is not done by the respondent-bank.

Affidavit of respondent filed today in the Court, is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Alongwith the affidavit, reply to the legal notice of the petitioner and order dated 20.11.2019 passed on the legal notice are annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent-bank has wrongly refused to release the property as other property was given as mortgage in lieu of earlier property.

The said aspect cannot be gone into in the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of as there is substantial compliance of directions of this Court.

In such circumstances, no further interference is called for, the petition is disposed of.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance.
