Pursuant to order dated 27.08.2019, Mr. Ashok Kumar Sharma, Director Secondary Education, Hayrana is present in Court today. Learned State counsel, on his instructions, states that as per directions of this Court in order dated 15.05.2018 passed in CWP No. 7523 of 2015, needful has been done. The payments would be released within three weeks from today. He further undertakes that the detailed calculations of the amount would also be provided to the petitioner. He further states that the proceedings have been initiated to pin-point the defaulting officials for the delay in complying the directions of this Court. He submits that compliance report with regard to the action taken would be filed in this Court within four months from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. In case, the payment is not released within three weeks from

today, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case, the petitioners are forced to revive the contempt petition, exemplary costs may be imposed which shall be recovered personally from the defaulting official.
