Angrej Singh-petitioner herein prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.43 dated 10.6.2017 registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh has submitted that prosecution has already recorded evidence of five witnesses and statement of remaining witnesses can be recorded expeditiously keeping in view the fact that all are police/Government officials.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner, particularly, when trial of the case has already made substantial progress. However, learned Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial within three months. Senior

Superintendent of Police, Shri Muktsar Sahib is requested to ensure the presence of police/Government officials for deposition on the date fixed.
