RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

1. By way of this petition, the petitioner has sought for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant the benefit of parole to the petitioner for a period of eight weeks on account of illness of his mother Gurmail Kaur.

2. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment under Sections 302/323/341/34 IPC and Section 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, in case FIR No.197 dated 18.12.2013 registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana.

3. Written statement by way of short affidavit of Rajiv Kumar Arora, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, dated 27.11.2019, has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

4. The affidavit bears out that the local police has no objection to the parole being granted to the petitioner, whose mother namely Gurmail Kaur, aged 63 years, is presently sick and bed ridden.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted parole for eight weeks from the date of release to the satisfaction of

the District Magistrate concerned, who is further directed to impose such conditions as required to secure the presence of the petitioner in jail after the period of parole, is over and done with.
