The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 09.10.2018, vide which, direction was issued to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representations of the petitioners and decide the same preferably within 60 days.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.1 dated 03.04.2019 is already on record. As per the said reply, direction was issued to Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana to conduct a detailed enquiry pertaining to the allegations mentioned in the representations dated 11.09.2018 and 19.09.2018. Petitioner No.1 was duly associated with the enquiry proceedings. The detailed enquiry report has also been placed on record as Annexure R-1/T. It is further stated that civil disputes are already pending between the parties in the Civil Courts, hence no action was warranted on the representations submitted by the petitioner and further

No.5, MHC of P.S. Division No.5, Ludhiana as well as Women help line have been provided in case of any police help is required at any time.

In view of the same, no further order is required to be passed in the present contempt petition. The same is dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, the petitioners are otherwise at liberty to avail remedy as available to them, in accordance with law, in case they are still aggrieved.
