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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed for grant of bail in case FIR No. 84, dated 2.8.2018, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

As per allegations, 700 strips each strip containing 10/10 tablets, total 7000 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride 100 mg clovidol 100 SR were recovered from petitioner.

FSL report has been received as per which the weight of contraband is 98.76 mg per tablet. The recovery is commercial.

Accordingly, no ground for grant of bail is made out.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner is in custody since 2.8.2018. Though, charges were framed against petitioner in March, 2019, however, despite availing 14 opportunities, the prosecution has failed to examine even single witness.

Considering the aforesaid, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent State to make efforts to expedite the trial.
