The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.415 dated 19.12.2018 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

On 21.11.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 14.02.2019. Thereafter, the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court and he absented on one date i.e. 21.10.2019, as he was suffering from acute chest pain and illness and despite the request made, his appearance was not exempted and bail/surety bonds were forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and face the trial.

Notice of motion for 18.12.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 21.11.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail and has also deposited the cost of Rs. 2,000/- imposed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 21.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
