The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 221 dated 15.06.2019, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had not been served at the address wherein he was residing. He also contends that he has been served at his official address which he had vacated in April, 2016.

This Court, by the order dated 19.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Ram Niwas, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 19.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
