INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.227 dated 13.11.2018, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, Jalandhar, under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that complainant-Mangat Singh, who was posted as Supervisor in Nisha Securities, has got the present FIR

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registered. It is stated in the FIR that one mobile tower of Indus Company was installed at village Mallian and the present petitioner alongwith co-accused had stolen two batteries from the tower after breaking the locks. The batteries are still to be recovered. There is nothing at this stage to show that this FIR is false one.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and recovery is yet to be effected, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that the petitioner is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
