This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 13.07.2018 passed in CWP No. 16999 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“Without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the Divisional Canal officer, Abohar Canal Division, Abohar, District Fazilka-respondent No.3 to consider the representation and legal notice (Annexure P-4 and P-5 respectively) of the petitioners and pass a speaking order thereon. Needful be done within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of Mukhtiar Singh Rana, Divisional Canal Officer, Abohar Canal Division, Abohar, District Fazilka annexing the order dated 17.08.2019, in Court today. Copy has been handed over to counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail the remedies in accordance with law, if still some grievance survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty, as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
