This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to pass necessary order to dispose of the application dated 01.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner-bank under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and to provide physical possession of the mortgaged property situated at Ludhiana in the time bound manner as detailed in the application dated 01.11.2017 (Annexure P-3)
