The grievance of the petitioner in this case is that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, is not taking any action upon his representation dated 30.09.2019. The petitioner claims to be the authorized seller/retailer-cum-registered commission agent of M/s Pan India Network Limited, Ludhiana, a marketer of online lottery tickets. According to the petitioner, no separate permission/licence is required for sale of such lottery tickets. The certificate (Annexure P-1) issued by the Assistant Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Ludhiana-II, bears out this fact. Despite the same, he complains that the police authorities are interfering with his sale of such lottery tickets.

Mr. Rajnikant Upadhyay, learned counsel for the petitioner, would point out that when similarly situated persons approached this Court by way of CWP-13437-2019, the same was disposed of permitting them to

ventilate their grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur. A copy of the order dated 20.05.2019 passed in the said writ petition is placed on record.

For reasons alike as were stated in the aforestated order and in terms thereof, this writ petition is disposed of directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to take appropriate action, as warranted, upon the representation dated 30.09.2019 made by the petitioner, in accordance with law. This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
