The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1097 dated 01.10.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 427, 506, 455, 120-B of IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner and other accused had caused damage to the hotel of the complainant. He also contends that no one was injured in the occurrence. The petitioner is 25 years of age and is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for almost 01 month and 21 days

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the petitioner alongwith others have caused heavy damage to the hotel of the complainant.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost 1 month and 21 days, he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
