The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.130 dated 22.10.2018, under Sections 379-B, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that ear rings of the complainant had been snatched. Co accused of the petitioner, namely, Malkit Singh has been acquitted at the conclusion of the trial. The petitioner had earlier, approached this Court and a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48205 of 2018 had directed that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 02 months and 21 days, he is 21 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI-Gurvinder Singh states that although charges have been framed but none of the witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the

petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 02 months and 21 days, he is 21 years of age, he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
