The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for issuance of appropriate direction to the Investigating Officer to admit the petitioner on bail in case FIR No.34 dated 05.02.2019 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act and Sections 307, 34 IPC (Sections 120-B, 193, 195, 365 IPC added later on) at Police Station Hasanpur, District Palwal.

A bare perusal of the facts on record shows that there is direct allegation against the petitioner that she brought the gun, with which her brother Imran fired a shot upon the injured. Subsequently, the gun, with which the fire-shot was made, is stated to have even been recovered from the house of the petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere at this stage.

Dismissed.
