Prayer in the application filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') is for correction in the head note as well as prayer clause of the petition.

In view of the facts mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and criminal complaint number mentioned in the head note and prayer clause of the petition be read as COMI/212/2019 instead of COMI/10554/2019.

Prayer in the application filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for placing of record certified copies of zimni orders dated 03.10.2019 (wrongly mentioned in the application as 02.10.2019) and 24.10.2019 passed by learned Trial Court as Annexure P/2 (colly) and also for exemption from filing typed copies thereof.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and copies of zimni orders dated 03.10.2019 and 24.10.2019 are taken on record as Annexure P/2 (colly) and the petitioner is also exempted from filing typed copies thereof.

CRM-M-49199-2019

The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the Trial Court to decide the Criminal Complaint No.COMI/212/2019 (wrongly mentioned as COMI/10554/2019) titled 'Deepak Sandhu Vs. Swami Ramdev and others' qua the prayer for sending the same under Section 156 (3) of the Cr.P.C. for registration of FIR and investigation by the police.

Copies of the zimni orders passed by the Trial Court have been perused. On 03.10.2019, the complaint was adjourned to 29.10.2019 but on 29.10.2019, the Presiding Officer was on leave on which the complaint was adjourned to 05.12.2019 and now the case is fixed for 10.02.2020.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the Trial Court is directed to pre-pone the case and hear the complainant and pass order qua the prayer for sending complaint under Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C. for registration of FIR and investigation by the police within 15 working days from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
