Petitioner Dhanveer Singh @ Dony has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.144 dated 05.06.2019, under Sections 323, 324 326, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural) (Annexure P-1) as well as the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-9).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant was having relationship with his sister, namely, Satbir Kaur @ Noor, who had given a complaint against him. He has referred to the voice messages allegedly sent by the complainant (Annexure P-3) to the sister of the petitioner to contend that he had extended threats as well. He further argued that (Annexure P-11) clearly established this fact that the petitioner was not present at the spot and the tower location of his mobile phone was produced by him before the Investigating Officer, who has not taken it into consideration for filing the final report against him.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the petition is founded on disputed facts and it will not be

appropriate for this Court to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR. It may be added here that the final report is yet to be considered by the trial Court and it shall be open for the petitioner to raise all these issues before the trial Court at the stage of framing of charges.

The petition is dismissed.
