ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out of FIR No.102 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Sections 21/22/29/61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station, City Nawanshahar District SBS Nagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, co-accused of the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 20 gm heroin and 20 injections of Buprenorphine each containing 2 ml.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused on the statement of co-accused, which is very weak type of evidence.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on the instructions of ASI Rampal, has informed the Court that the petitioner is a habitual drug paddler, already convicted in 10 cases under the NDPS Act. He has further informed the Court that there are other cases under the NDPS Act pending against her.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
