By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

The quantity of contraband stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the prosecution), being 204 grams of 'Tramadol' and 59 grams of 'Alprazolam', eventually both of which are below commercial quantity and “clubbing them together” would be difficult in view of the fact that each drug has its own 'measurement' for what quantity is commercial and what is non-commercial, with the petitioner also stated to be a first time offender who has been in custody for about 4 ½ months, with no prosecution witness having been examined so far, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the trial.

Consequently, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court.
