The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 20 dated 05.04.2017, registered under Sections 297, 195 and 193 of the IPC at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

On 08.01.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the course of investigation, the petitioner was found to be innocent and now she has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. List again on 14.02.2019. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 25.01.2019 and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail, subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 08.01.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail and thereafter, the charge

has been amended and she is facing trial.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.01.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
