On 19.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.0067 dated 03.09.2019 registered under Sections 323, 452, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur.

First informant is daughter of the petitioner who claims to have been living in a Live-In-Relationship. She claims that her father alongwith other relatives came and tried to take her back.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Mr. Tejinder Kataria, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Adjourned to 06.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as

provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 19.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
