This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to release detenu Sanjay from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds it strange that as per the pleadings, initially 35 labourers along with the petitioner were brought for work at the alleged brick kiln and most of them were allegedly thrown out of the brick kiln except one alleged detainee.

The pleadings in the writ petition appear to be self contradictory and do not inspire confidence, therefore, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

The petition is dismissed.
