On 25.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.277 dated 4.10.2018 registered under Sections 306, 120-B IPC at Police Station, Division 6, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that brother-in-law of the petitioner had committed suicide due to matrimonial discord which was resolved through a settlement with the intervention of the respectables of the society. However, Late Sh. Gobind considered that such a settlement is under pressure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that offence under Section 306 IPC, ingredients whereof as defined under Section 107 IPC, is not made out.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. AG,

Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab respondent No.1 and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Let notice be issued to respondent no.2 for 10.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 25.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
