The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.25212 of 2016.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of this uncontroverted position, the writ petition is allowed. The respondents are directed to release the plot of the petitioners or alternatively, acquire all the adjoining vacant plots so as to eliminate the ground of discrimination. In case the adjoining vacant plots are not acquired within a period of three months, the plot of the petitioners shall stand released subject to their deposit of development charges etc., if any.”

Upon notice, learned State counsel has produced an order of the Apex Court whereby, the judgment dated 15.01.2018 of this Court has been stayed.

In view of this development, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition, at this stage.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

Needless to say that petitioners can avail remedies in accordance with law in case something survives after the decision of the Apex Court.
