Hysterectomy is not a medical condition which persuades this Court to release the petitioner on emergency parole to attend to his wife. It is an operation for removal of uterus and the petitioner is not a Doctor. It is best that he keeps away from his wife in view of the nature of the surgery to be performed. She has family to care for her. No ground for any indulgence to be shown to the petitioner is made out.

Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed.
